Pittsburgh Drill Competition
Saturday June 2, 2012

Number of teams: 24 (each team consists of 3 members) \$30 entry fee per team

Best team time wins competition. The winning team will have successfully entered course, discovered downed firefighter, remove them from any entrapment/entanglement, placed downed firefighter on alternate air, package the victim for removal, and then remove downed firefighter by the same route the team entered. Each team member must exit course by way they entered while on air and all PPE intact (tools may be left on course, but teams are encouraged to finish the course as they started).

Failure to convert downed firefighter to alternate air AND turn alternate air on will eliminate the team.

Failure to exit the course by the same way entered on air (if a team member runs out of air while on the course they are ruled 'deceased') will eliminate the entire team.

No part of the course may be altered (no breaking studs, 2' X 2' tube, etc.).

The drill simulates medium to high heat conditions so standing up to drag the victim is unacceptable.

Time will start when first team member crosses the stud wall at the start of the course. Time will end when the last team member clears the same stud wall.

Each team will be able to examine the course prior to the competition.

An alternate air supply will be provided for each team to use.

Vision inhibition material will be provided to each team.

Each team will need to provide their PPE including SCBA that is date test certified.

Each team member will be required to sign a waiver prior to competing.

Each team is welcome to bring their hand tools and webbing to use.

Each team will need to be on-site and checked in one hour prior to start time.

The winning team will have a brick donated in their honor to the State Fallen Firefighter Memorial. 1st, 2nd and 3rd place team members will receive a Middle Tennessee FOOLS challenge coin.
